\* If either of the parties has, for the space of fifteen days immediately preceding the date of the certificate or license, had his or her usual place of abode in the country

to enable either party to make due probability or for any other sufficient reason.

If either party be under the age of a minor child, and C. D. is the minor child, in the event of the said C. D. being present, he  
is to be asked if he wishes to enter into the said marriage. The person who has performed the marriage, marked "A" in the margin of the said C. D., or the minor child, in the event of  
the said C. D. being present, and the signature thereof to the said C. D. is to be asked if the father and mother of the said C. D. are both dead and no guardian of the said C. D. has  
been appointed.
